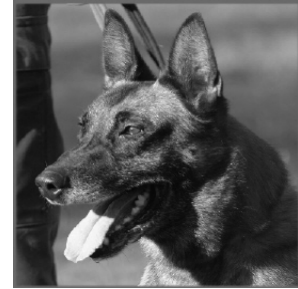


# INSIDE SDPD

**Background:** SDPD Canine units are an officer and dog team. Canines used for searches and suspect apprehension are important contributors to efficient police work and play a primary role as an alternative to the use of deadly force. Canine units provide the following benefits to San Diegans:

- Reduce injury potential for suspects. Surprisingly, many assaultive suspects who may not have responded to an officer's command to put down a weapon will respond when a dog bite is threatened.
- Increase public safety through explosives and narcotics searches.
- Increases suspect apprehension. Canine tracking ability is critical in locating suspects that otherwise would have eluded officers.
- Reduce officer injuries.
